

## **Entering Concert and Sightreading Contest with Non Varsity and Sub-Non Varsity Groups**

- When designating your first non varsity group for concert and sightreading, remember to also indicate the group as Non Varsity. All other non varsity groups should be entered as sub-non varsity.
- Sub-Non Varsity Classification is its own unique classification; therefore for the next non varsity would be entered as a Sub-Non Varsity **A**, then the next as a Sub-Non Varsity **B**, etc. Sub-Non Varsity groups will be scheduled before Non Varsity and Varsity groups when possible.
- This allows groups of like classification to be grouped together when possible by conference when we schedule the contest.

## **Explanation Period Extensions for Sub-Non Varsity Groups**

- Sub-Non Varsity Bands will have the Summary Explanation Period extended by one minute – this extends the summary period from three to four minutes.
- Class C Non Varsity Bands will also have their summary period extended by one minute - this extends the summary period from three to four minutes.
- Sub-Non Varsity Choirs will have the first Study and Instruction Period extended by one minute – this extends the first period from six to seven minutes. The second instructional period may not be extended.
- Sub-Non Varsity Orchestras will have the Instruction Period extended by one minute.
